

Addendum to KCSF Minutes dated: June 17, 2009

BOWS Report-Mary Kaneakalau

BOWS acknowledges Soccer Park as best fields in town; would like to have tournaments at park. Question-Will lights be available in August? PRicker answers; that more than likely not as money and electrician are issues.

- BOWS will not have Moonlight this year due to lack of lights; asking that \$500 deposit be moved to hold fields for February Invitational (2/21-22/2010). Accepted by Board.

Question-Where in process is tournament application policy? PRicker answers; on hold due to VP Suspension. BOWS would like to continue to participate in this policy development.

Question-What is status of suspension? PRicker answers; not at liberty to discuss, a hearing is coming up in 3-4 weeks.

Question-Status of Tournament Contract? CAnderson answers; still working on contract.

Comment: BOWS is an adult league with resources available on a volunteer basis. BOWS offered electrician services to diagnose light problem and possibly repair, were told that insurance is an issue.

Question- Does the Park insurance cover the volunteers offering assistance at the park? PRicker answers; some coverage, but not workmen's comp. MaryK-Can we get coverage?

- DPatrick answers; depends on policy, has experience with her agent, had volunteers included, willing to look at KCSF Park Policy and speak with her agent for suggestions, requests copy of insurance policy to review. Board Agrees.

Comment: BOWS wants to help, income and fundraising seem to be the greatest concern.

Question-What can be done to help? TMartin answers; he needs physical bodies to make contact with the hotels to follow-up on his initial request for monies. BOWS-would it be possible to meet and discuss options and ideas? Mary K and Kathy Scatena from BOWS will meet with Tom on Tuesday, July 6th (5:30 pm) at Casa Munoz on Union; others are welcome. Board Agrees Committee to report back to Board
